E-NIT in two bid systems are invited on behalf of MMTC Limited (A Govt. of India Enterprises), MMTC House, C-22, Block 'E', Bandra Kurla Complex, Bandra (East), Mumbai-400 051 for supply of photocopier machines having experience of more than 3 years.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- E-bidder should have overall turnover of minimum Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs) as service provider of photocopier machine during the last three years i.e. 2016-17, 2017-18 & 2018-19 and in support thereof their balance sheets/profit & loss accounts duly certified by their Chartered Accountant be attached.
- E-bidder should have minimum experience of three years in empanelment of service provider for photocopier machines in Central Government/State PSU(s)/State Government Department/Semi-Govt. Department / PSU/MNC and should submit copies of award letters in support thereof duly attested.
- E-bidder should have executed contract as empanelment of service provider for photocopier machines in the past and should have got valid licence from the competent authority (copy to be submitted)
- E-bidder must submit copies of valid PAN/GSTN along with e-tender.
- Copy of Credentials in support of empanelment of photocopier machines and similar work (provision of miscellaneous services in different sections as per enclosed scope of the work) from Govt. Organizations.
- Average Annual financial turnover during last 3 years ending 31st March of the previous financial year, should not be less than Rs. 2 Lakhs.
- Experience certificate of having successfully completed works during the last 3 years ending last day of month previous to the one should be as follows:-
- Three similar completed supply of empanelment of service provider for photocopier machines costing not less than amount equal to Rs. 2,00,000/- (Two Lakhs only)
- Two similar completed empanelment of service provider for photocopier machines costing less than amount equal to Rs. 2,00,000/-(Two Lakhs Only)
- One similar completed works empanelment of service provider for photocopier machines costing not less than amount equal to Rs.2,00,000/- (Two Lakh Only)
- List of supply order related to service provider for photocopier machines contract executed by the firm, in MMTC Limited to be provided in technical bid (if applicable).
- Offer should be as per tender specification only and no deviation will be entertained.
- Firm has to produce certificate duly ink signed by CA for status whether firm is proprietary/partnership, etc.
- E-bidder must deposit e-tender fee (non refundable) of Rs. 1,000/- through epayment in the account of the MMTC Limited, Mumbai. (Refer to appendix)
- E-bidder should submit financial capability through latest Income Tax annual report.
- Submission of e-bid will be only through e-tender process.
- GST will be applicable as per latest notifications.
- Under Public Procurement Policy (PPP) issued by Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Government of India for Micro & Small Enterprises (MSMEs), a minimum 25% share out of the total procurement of goods and

services by Central Ministries / Departments / Public Sector Undertakings are to be made from MSEMs. Further out of 25% target of annual procurement from MSMEs, a sub target of 4% is earmarked for procurement from MSEs owned by SC/ST entrepreneurs. Further, minimum 3% reservation for women owned MSEs within the above mentioned 25% reservation to make it more inclusive.

- In case the party is registered with Ministry of MSME/its authorized agencies, the e-bidder is required to submit, registration certificate. The MSMEs parties will be eligible for the benefits as applicable to them under MSMEs Act, 2006.
- MMTC reserves the right to increase or decrease the tender quantity or duration or both.
- A successful e-bidder shall submit interest free Performance Security Deposit (PSD) of Rs. 20,000/-(Rs. Twenty Thousand only) including EMD (interest free) for total supply order value within 30 days of receipt of supply order. This PSD and EMD will be returned/adjusted against dues, if any at the end of contract period.
- A successful e-bidder shall furnish list of successful clients.
- A successful e-bidder should not change contract during its execution without prior permission of the MMTC management
- A successful e-bidder should not sub-let/sub-contract/assign the main contractual work during the contractual period.

- The e-TECHNICAL BIDs shall be opened on schedule date/ time in MMTC office in presence of the tenderers, who wish to be present on the date of opening.
- The e-TECHNICAL BIDS shall be scrutinized/ verified by a Committee in terms of the tender/scope of the work and subsequently the eligible PRICE BIDS shall be opened within a week. The date will be intimated to the participants.
- The period of empanelment of service provider for photocopier machines at MMTC House, BKC, Bandra(E), MMTC's office at Sahar Cargo and Seepz Unit, Andheri shall be two years w.e.f. _____ The same shall be extendable only at the discretion of MMTC subject to satisfactory completion of work during contract period/ extended contract period. The decision of the MMTC shall be final and binding on the successful e-bidder in this regard.
- The Tender should remain valid for a period of 60 (sixty) days from the date of opening of the **PRICE BID**.
- All pages of the offer must be signed/ sealed by the tenderers.
- The e-tenders with any additional conditions/ deviations by the tenderers, whatsoever shall be rejected.
- The e-tenderer shall quote the rates in English Language and International numerals. These rates shall be entered in figures as well as in words. In case of difference in rates between words and figures, the rates mentioned in words shall be treated as valid and final.
- All entries in the tender shall be typed/written in ink. Erasers and over writing are not permitted and such tenders may be liable for rejection. The tenderer shall duly attest all cancellations and insertions.
- The Earnest money deposit may be forfeited in the event of:
 i) If a tenderer withdraws its tender during the period of tender's validity.
 ii) In case of successful tenderer, if the tenderer fails to commence the work, as required.
- The Earnest money deposit of unsuccessful tenderers shall be returned within reasonable time without any interest. The EMD (interest free) of successful tenderer shall be retained and converted as part of interest free Security deposit, to be refunded after successful completion of contract after adjustment of dues, if any.
- If the successful e-bidder deliberately gives wrong information in tender, MMTC reserves the right to reject such tender at any stage or to cancel the contract, if awarded and forfeit the Earnest Money/Security deposit/ any other moneys due without prejudice of taking legal resource.
- MMTC do not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to reject any or all the Tenders in full or part, without assigning any reasons thereof.
- The successful e-bidder must comply with all terms and conditions contained herein.

- The successful e-bidder shall require to submit an Affidavit as per annexure D and enter into an agreement as per annexure-C. The terms and conditions of the e-bid documents and all other correspondence, shall also form an integral part of the agreement to be entered into with successful bidder of tender
- The successful e-bidder shall submit a performance guarantee amount through e-mode to the MMTC Limited, Mumbai of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand only) The Performance Guarantee amount shall be released to Successful bidder on successful and satisfactorily execution of the said contract. No claim shall be admissible against MMTC in respect of interest on Performance Guarantee regardless of the time of the release. The Performance Guarantee amount can be forfeited by order of the MMTC in the event of any breach or negligence or for non-acceptance of any condition of contract or for unsatisfactory performance or for non-execution of work by successful bidder. On expiry of the contract, such portion of the said Performance Guarantee amount as may be appropriated for any losses/damages occurred to MMTC. On which decision of MMTC is final & binding on successful bidder

• Termination Clause:

1 Right to Terminate the Process

MMTC reserves the right to cancel the contract/agreement placed on the selected e-bidder and recover expenditure incurred by MMTC under the

following circumstances:-

- The successful e-bidder commits breach of any of the terms and conditions of the bid. The bidder goes into liquidation, voluntarily or otherwise.
- If the successful e-bidder fails to complete the assignment/deliver the services as agreed herein as per the time lines and guidelines prescribed in this e-tender and subsequent Contract and the extension, if any allowed, it will be a breach of contract. MMTC reserves its right to cancel the contract.
- In the event of the successful bidder being adjudged insolvent or having a receiver appointed for it by a court or any other order under the Insolvency Act made against them or in case of a successful bidder passing any resolution or making of any order for winding up, whether voluntary or otherwise, or in the event of the successful bidder failing to comply with any of the conditions herein specified, MMTC shall have the power to terminate the contract without previous notice.
- In case selected e-bidder fails to deliver the services as stipulated in the agreement/contract, MMTC reserve the right to procure the same or similar services from alternate sources at the risk, cost and responsibility of the selected bidder. In such event EMD and Performance Security Deposit should stand forfeited.
- After award of the agreement, if the selected e-bidder does not perform satisfactory or delays execution of the agreement, MMTC reserves the right to get the agreement for remaining period executed by another party of its choice by giving one month notice for the same. In this event, the selected e-bidder is bound to make good the additional expenditure, which MMTC may have to incur for the same. This clause is applicable, if for any reason, the agreement is cancelled.
- MMTC reserves the right to recover any dues payable by the successful bidder from any amount outstanding to the credit of the selected e-bidder including from the pending bills and/or invoking the performance security deposit under this agreement.
- Consequences of Termination
- In the event of termination of the Agreement/contract due to any cause whatsoever, MMTC shall be entitled to impose any such obligations and conditions and issue any clarification as may be necessary to ensure an efficient transition and effective

business continuity of the Service(s)/scope of work intended under the present tender which the successful bidder shall be obliged to comply with and take all available steps to minimize loss resulting from the termination/breach, and further allow the next successor to take over the obligations of the erstwhile successful bidder in relation to the execution/continued execution of the scope of the Agreement.

- Nothing herein shall restrict the right of MMTC to invoke the Guarantee and other guarantees, securities furnished, enforce Indemnity of successful bidder and pursue such other rights and/or remedies / legal recourse that may be available to MMTC under law or otherwise against successful bidder.
- The termination hereof shall not affect any accrued right or liability of either Party nor affect the operation of the provisions of the Agreement / contract that are expressly or by implication intended to come into or continue in force on or after such termination.

Relationship between the Parties

• Nothing in the subsequent Agreement / contract constitutes any fiduciary relationship between MMTC and

Selected Bidder/ Bidder's Team or any relationship of employee employee, principal and agent, or partnership, between the MMTC and Selected Bidder.

• No Party has any authority to bind the other Party in any manner whatsoever except as agreed under the terms of the subsequent Agreement / Contract.

• MMTC will not be under any obligation to the subsequent successful bidder except as agreed under the terms of the Agreement / Contract.

• <u>No Assignment:</u>

The Selected Bidder shall not sub-contract, transfer, assign or otherwise part with the tender/Agreement or any part thereof, either directly or indirectly or transfer any interest, right, benefit or obligation under the agreement.

• Waiver:

The failure of either party to enforce or to exercise at any time or for any period, any term of or any right pursuant to this tender/agreement shall not be construed as a waiver of any such term or right and shall in no way affect that party's right later to enforce or exercise it.

• Governing Law:

This agreement/contract shall be governed in accordance with the laws of India.

<u>Arbitration Clause:</u>

Any dispute or difference in respect of any matter relating to or arising out of the contract, if the same is not solved amicably, will be settled at Mumbai by Arbitration in accordance with the rules of arbitration of Indian Council of Arbitration (ICA), Delhi and the award made in pursuance thereof shall be final & binding on the parties. The venue of Arbitration shall be Mumbai.

• <u>Continuance of the Contract:</u>

Notwithstanding the fact that settlement of dispute(s) (if any) under arbitration may be pending, the parties hereto shall continue to be governed by and perform the work in accordance with the provisions under the Scope of Work to ensure continuity of operations and in such case EMD and Performance Security Deposit will be with held by MMTC till the settlement.

• <u>Publicity:</u>

The successful e-bidder shall not make or permit to be made a public announcement or media release about any aspect of this Contract unless the MMTC first gives its written consent to do so.

• <u>Indemnity</u>:

The successful bidder undertakes to fully indemnify and at all times keep MMTC fully indemnified and harmless against any actions, sanctions, claims, losses, damages, demands, expenses or costs whatsoever that MMTC may incur and / or suffer on account of any default on the part of the successful bidder in discharge of the obligation under the agreement, including but not limited to the claims on account of any other circumstances incidental to the scope of work. In case, successful bidder fails / has failed to give the services as agreed in the tender, scope of work, terms and condition, subsequent agreement, undertaking or if MMTC at its sole discretion considers that the successful bidder is not in a position to fulfill its obligations, MMTC may without being obliged to do so and without prejudice to any of its other rights and remedies, repudiate this agreement and procure the scope of work done at the cost and risk of the successful bidder from alternative sources. The provisions of the aforementioned indemnity clause shall survive the termination of the agreement.

• <u>Confidentiality and safeguard of Property</u>:

MMTC and Successful bidder respectively agree to keep in confidence, and not to disclose or use for its own respective benefit or for the benefit of any third party (except as may be required for the performance of services under the agreement or as may be required by law), any information, documents, or materials that are reasonably considered confidential regarding each other's products, business, customers, MMTCs, suppliers, or methods of operation; provided, however, that such obligation of confidentiality will not extend to anything in the public domain or that was in the possession of either party prior to disclosure. MMTC and Successful bidder will take reasonable precautions to safeguard property of the other entrusted to it.

Force Majeure:

If at any time during the existence of this agreement either party is unable to perform in whole or in part any obligations under this agreement because of war, hostility, military operations, civil commotion, sabotage, quarantine, restrictions, acts of God and acts of Government (including but not restricted to prohibitions of exports and imports), fires,

floods, explosions, epidemics, strikes, or any other labour trouble, embargoes, then the date of fulfillment of any obligations engagement shall be postponed during the time when such circumstances are operative.

If operation of such circumstances exceeds **three months**, either party shall have the right to refuse further performance of the agreement in which case neither party shall have the right to claim eventual damages. The party which is unable to fulfill its obligations under the present agreement shall, within 15 days of occurrence of any of the causes mentioned in this clause inform the other party of the existence or termination of the circumstances preventing the performance of the agreement. Notwithstanding this, provisions relating to indemnity, confidentiality survive termination of the agreement.

Entire Agreement:

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The terms and conditions laid down in this Tender, subsequent agreement and all annexures thereto as also the Proposal and any attachments/annexes thereto shall be read in consonance with and form an integral part of the Agreement.

The subsequent draft agreement constitutes the whole of the agreement between the Parties relating to the matters dealt with herein alongwith any allied exchange correspondence and, save to the extent otherwise provided herein, no undertaking, representation, term or condition relating to the subject matter of this Agreement not incorporated in this Agreement shall not be binding on either of the Parties.

All provisions and the various clauses of subsequent contract/agreement are, notwithstanding the manner in which they have been grouped together or linked grammatically, severable from each other. Any provision or clause of subsequent Agreement which is or becomes unenforceable in any jurisdiction, whether due to voidness, invalidity, illegality, unlawfulness or for any other reason whatever, shall, in such jurisdiction only and only to the extent that it is so unenforceable, be treated as pro non scripto and the remaining provisions and clauses of subsequent Agreement shall remain of full force and effect. The Parties declare that it is their intention that Agreement would be executed without such unenforceable provision if they were aware of such unenforceability at the time of execution hereof.

<u>Signing of Tender:</u>

Each and every page of the tender document to be signed and stamped in acceptance of the terms and conditions. Individual signing the tender or other documents connected with contract must specify whether he/she signs as:

(a) A 'sole proprietor' of the concern or constituted attorney of such sole proprietor.

(b) a partner of the firm, if it be a partnership firm, in which case he must have authority to execute contracts on behalf of the firm and to refer to arbitration disputes concerning the business of the partnership either by virtue of the partnership contract or by a power of attorney duly executed by the partners of the firm.

(c) Director or a principal officer duly authorized by the Board or Directors of the Company, if it is a company.

N.B:

(1) In case of partnership firms;

i. a copy of the partnership deed or general power of attorney duly attested by a Notary Public should be furnished on stamped paper duly sworn or affirmed by all the partners admitting execution of the partnership contract or the general power of attorney. The attested copy of the certificate of registration of firm should also be enclosed along with the tender.

ii. In the case of partnership firms, where no authority to refer disputes concerning the business of partnership firm has been conferred on any partner, the tender and all other related documents must be signed by all partners of the firm.

(2) A person signing the tender form or any documents forming part of the tender on behalf of another person, he/she should have an authority to bind such other person and if, on enquiry it appears that the persons so signing had no authority to do so, MMTC may, without prejudice, cancel the contract and hold the signatory liable for all costs, consequences and damages under the civil and criminal remedies available.

• <u>Compliance with Laws:</u>

The selected Bidder shall comply with the laws in force in India in the course of performing the Agreement / Contract.

- During the performance of the work, the successful bidder shall at his own cost and initiative fully comply with all applicable laws of the land and with all applicable by-laws, labour laws, rules, regulations and any other provisions having the force of law, made or promulgated or deemed to be made or promulgated by any Government, Government agency, or Department, Municipal board, government or other regulatory or authorized body of persons and shall provide all certificates to MMTC of compliance therewith as may be required by such applicable law, by-laws, labour laws and rules, regulations, orders. The successful bidder shall assume full responsibility for the payment of all contributions and payroll taxes, as to its workforce, servants or agents engaged in the performance of the work specified in the tender / agreement documents
 - If during the tenure of work stipulated herein, successful bidder may found violating any laws, norms attributed & applicable from this tender / subsequent agreement / contract, in such event, the successful bidder will be solely liable to face the consequence of violation, in as much, the successful bidder may keep MMTC safe and indemnified from any of the lossess / risk which may occasioned by non-performing any statutory rules, regulation or law in force.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

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- The empanelment of service provider for photocopier machines to be executed in MMTC House, C-22, BKC, Bandra,(E)Mumbai, Sahar Cargo office and seepz unit..
- The quoted prices shall be exclusive of all taxes.
- Bill will be raised on monthly basis for all the machines viz., MMTC House, BKC, Sahar cargo office and Seepz Unit.
- The payment shall be processed and made upon receipt of original bill within a month period. In case any correction observed, bill will be returned back and settled after receipt of corrected bill.
- Electricity, paper and manpower shall be MMTC's responsibility.

• TDS and other statutory taxes (as applicable from time to time) shall be deducted at source from the bills.

• Escalation:

It may be noted that the successful e-bidder's rates for empanelment of service provider for photocopier machine shall be without any increase during the currency or extended period of the contract No escalation in offered rates through e-tender.

- The successful e-bidder shall be responsible for any injury caused to person(s) visiting MMTC for the repairing and replacement of carriage. Any damage caused to any property of MMTC etc. which may arise from the operations or negligence of any person of the successful e-bidder/contractors team or any person engaged by him for any purpose related to the execution of this contract. The successful e-bidder shall indemnify MMTC against all liabilities arising out of his operations in any way under any acts of the Government and also in award of any compensation or damaged consequent upon any claim arising out of above.
- In the event of any accident occurring during the course of work, which may result in any mishap, injury to delivery person(s), the responsibility of settlement of their claims, medical treatment etc. will fully rest with the successful e-bidder and expenditure incurred thereon will be borne entirely by the successful e-bidder. MMTC shall be kept totally indemnified of any liability whatsoever by the successful e-bidder.

• <u>Penalty:</u>

In the event of failure to maintain the empanelment of service provider for photocopier machine at MMTC House, BKC, Bandra(E), MMTC's office at Sahar Cargo and Seepz, Unit, Andheri, any day as per terms and conditions of this tender in part or in full, the successful e-bidder shall be liable for payment for damage charges @ Rs.5,000/- besides proportionate deduction which shall be recovered from monthly bills. 2. 3.
